

Francone Elementary Student Dress Code Guidelines

2018-2019

Appropriate dress and grooming are an important factor in the safe and orderly operation of schools. Our campus and district values and needs the support of parents in upholding the campus/district dress and grooming guidelines. The student and his/her parent(s) may determine the student's personal dress and grooming standards provided that the student's dress and grooming:

- shall not lead school officials to reasonably believe that such dress or grooming will disrupt, interfere with, disturb, or detract from school activities; and
- shall not create a health problem or safety hazard for the student or others.

Students are not to wear clothing that is tight, loose, sagging, baggy, revealing, spaghetti-strap, backless, low cut or short. The full district dress code can be found in the Student Handbook.

Francone's specific guidelines include:

- Pants must be worn at the waist or upper hip and must not reveal underclothing.
- Shorts/Skirts/Dresses must be no more than 4" above the knee.
- Tops must not reveal underclothing, midsection, back, chest, or cleavage.
- Shoes must be either tennis shoes or shoes with closed toes and heels (no sandals, jellies, flip-flops, pool shoes; heels higher than 1" or shoes without a back).
- Head Coverings – No type of head covering may be worn unless for religious or medical purposes, or on days designated by administration.
- Ear Piercings must not detract from the learning environment or present a safety or health hazard. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings.
- Tattoos – Permanent or temporary tattoos must be covered at all times.
- Hair must be well groomed, neat and clean at all times; hair style/color must not detract from the learning and school environment.
- Backpacks - Rolling backpacks are not allowed.

Students who are not in compliance with the dress code will not be allowed to attend class. Repeated violations can result in a loss of extra-curricular privileges.
